The report shall comply with the requirements as set forth in §§11164-11174.3 of the California Penal Code. This reporting requirement is in addition to any mandated reporting for accident or injury to Youth Participant or a YA employee, chaperon, actor or agent. In turn, if an individual involved with the YA is reported, all participation in the YA will immediately be suspended pending outcome of an internal investigation and investigation by the appropriate authorities to ensure the safety and well-being of all Youth Participants.
